Bristow	John	<p>Sacred To the Memory of JOHN BRISTOW Gent whofo Remains lie interred near this Place He departed this Life the 15<sup>th</sup> Feb: 1788 Aged 48 years</p>

Nott	John	<p style="text-align: center;">To the Memory of JOHN NOTT Esqr. of Braydon in the County of Wilts He died June 23<sup>rd</sup> 1763 Aged 64 And of ELIZABETH the Daughter of HENRY NEALE Esqr. of Allesbury in Warwickshire his Wife She died Sept. 6<sup>th</sup> 1746 Aged 44 They Left three surviving Sons John Neale Pleydell, Joseph, Roger and had many other Children who died in Infancy JOSEPH NOTT died at Madras in the East India's in 1769 without Issue</p>
Nott	John Neale Pleydell	<p style="text-align: center;">To perpetuate the Memory of JOHN NEALE PLEYDELL NOTT Esq. Commander of his Majesty's Ship Centaur who left his Life off Martinique April 29<sup>th</sup> 1781 in the 49<sup>th</sup> Year of his Age Gallantly supporting his Country's Cause against the French Fleet Commanded by Monsieur de Graffé He married CATHERINE Daughter of ROBT. ANDREWS Esqr. By whom he left Issue three Sons, JOHN, EDWARD &amp; GEORGE and two Daughters, DIANA &amp; ELIZABETH</p>

Nott	John	<p style="text-align: center;">This os Inferibed to the Memory of  <b>JOHN NOTT</b>  eldefit Son of the late Capt. J.N.P. NOTT  Firtt Lieut. Of his Majesty's Ship Succesfs  He was carried off by the Yellow Fever  at Port Royal Jamaica on the 18<sup>th</sup> August 1794  in the 24<sup>th</sup> Year of his Age  Alfo to the Memory of his youngeft Brother  <b>GEORGE NOTT</b>  who fell a Sacrifice to the fame dreadful diforder  in November 1795 in the Weft Indies  on Board his Majesty's Ship Beaulieu  in the 17<sup>th</sup> Year of his Age  Though Cut off at fo early a Period  they promifed not only to be an ornament  to their Profefsion but to their Country  In private life their Virtues were fuch  as to make their lofs ever to be lamented  by all who knew them  The affliction of their furviving Parent  (by whom this Monument is erected)  is too Poignant for defeription</p>
Pleydell	Edward	<p style="text-align: center;">In Memory of <b>EDWARD PLEYDELL</b> Gent  who dyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> of February 1675  Alfo <b>MARY</b> wife of the faid <b>EDWARD PLEYDELL</b>  who dyed the 13<sup>th</sup> of April 1712  And alfo Mrs. <b>ELIZABETH PLEYDELL</b> Daughter of  the above <b>EDWARD</b> &amp; <b>MARY</b> who died the 9<sup>th</sup> of July  1737  The Said Mrs. <b>ELIZABETH PLEYDELL</b> gave Twenty  Shill 1p Ann to the poor of this Parifh for Ever  Mrs.  <b>MARY MORGAN</b>  Died Feby. 24<sup>th</sup> 1763  Aged 77 Years</p>

Smyth	Henry	<p style="text-align: center;">To  The Memory of  Major HENRY SMITH  Born in Cricklade May 1<sup>st</sup> 1776.  Gazetted Ensign in the  Nottingham Militia 1799 and  in 1804, Ensign in H. M. 39<sup>th</sup> Reft.  In which he served 33 years  through the campaigns of  Malta, Sicily, the Peninsula  and the East Indies  Died in Sandown, Isle of Wight  July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1867, aged 91 years  Father in thee have I trusted.  Bless me, even me, or my father  and of ELIZABETH, wife of  Major HENRY SMYTH  who departed this life in  Sandown, Isle of Wight, the  21<sup>st</sup> November 1862, in the 80<sup>th</sup>  year of her age; beloved  by all who knew her.  The body shall return to dust.  The spirit to him gave who gave it.</p>
