## **Interesting Parish Register Entries**

6 Oct 1678 - George Harrell, of Hankerton, co. Wilts, & Catharine Jeamson (Jamesson) [relict of the late Rector, married 2 Feb. 1664/5]. Nuptiae autem celebratea sunt in ecclesia parochiali de Newnton. (Roughly translates to the autumn nuptials being celebrated in the ecclesial parish of Newnton).

7 Apr 1686 - The entries begin now, generally speaking, to be made in English; practically all before have been in Latin.

14 Oct 1694-13 May 1695 These five entries are dated 1694 in the Register, but it is possible from the order that the entries of 2 Jan. and 24 Mar. belong to 1694/5 and that of 13 May to 1695.

1718 On Oct. 21 was buried Thomas Shewring, Rector.

William Stanmore & Hester Starkes, both of C. 13 Mar 1791. The entry of this Marriage, with the Banns, is written on a sheet of paper which is signed by the parties, the witnesses, and the officiating minister, Wm. Thorp, Curate, and fastened to the page in the book by a pin.
