Daniel Smith, a scrap merchant found picking snowdrops in the grounds of a senior officers' school near Devizes (Wiltshire), was fined £1 sterling yesterday for damaging War Department property. (*The West Australian*)

20 Aug 1954 - BEDSIDE COURT ON HEARING.

A bedside court will be held at Devizes Hospital, Wiltshire on August 27 to hear evidence from Lord Vivian, 48 year old West End impresario, who was shot on July 30. Mrs. Mary Wheller, 40, who is charged with having shot at him with intent to murder, applied for bail yesterday, but it was again refused by the Devizes magistrates.
