The case of Edward Owen Bishop (formerly of Devizes), a clerk in the employ of the Wilts and Dorset Banking Company, at Christchurch, who was committed to take his trial at the Hampshire Sessions, on a charge of embezzling £1191 8s. 6d., was removed by certiorari to the Court of the Queen's Bench, and the prisoner admitted to bail. The case will, in all probability, come on at the ensuing Assizes.
