

Estate Administration Devizes 1870

The Estate of Catherine Purrier

PURSUANT to the Statute 22nd and 23rd Victoria, cap. 35, intituled "An Act to further amend the Law of Property and to relieve Trustees:" *Notice is hereby given* that all Persons claiming DEBTS or LIABILITIES affecting the ESTATE of CATHERINE PURRIER formerly of *Modbury*, in the County of Devon, but late of *Devises*, in the County of Wilts, Widow, deceased, who died on the 17th day of October 1870, and whose Will was proved on the 12th day of November 1870, by the REV. HENRY THORNTON PURRIER, the Executor named in the said Will, are to send to MESSRS.
