This is the last Will and Testament of me Ann Mulcock of Devizes in the County of Wilts Widow I give to my sister Mary Woodward my best china tea set and my silver tea pot I give to henry Kidd the eldest son of my nephew Henry Kidd my silver pint cup I give to my nephew Henry Kidd the sum of five pounds and subject to the payment of all my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses and the legacies hereinbefore mentioned I give and bequeath all the residue of my Personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever unto my Nephew Henry Kidd for his own absolute use and benefit And I appoint my said Nephew Henry Kidd Executor of this my Will and hereby revoke all other Wills by me at any time heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name the seventeenth day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty eight Ann Mulcock
