I Sarah Phene of the Borough of Devizes in the County of Wilts Widow do make this my last Will and Testament as follows I give unto my Son The Reverend Phinehas Phene and to his Wife my Daughter in Law Frances Phene the Sum of fifty pounds as and for mourning and I give unto my Son in Law Nicholas Peter Phene the portrait picture of his father my late Husband and I give unto the said Nicholas Peter Phene the Sum of one hundred pounds all the rest residue and remainder of my Goods Chattels money Securities for money Debts Effects and Estates whatsoever and wheresoever I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Phene To hold to him the said Samuel Phene his Executors Administrators and Assigns As his and their own proper Goods and Chattels money Securities for money Debts Effects and Estates whatsoever and wheresoever I give and bequeath unto my Son Samuel Phene To hold to him my said Son Samuel Phene his Executors Administrators and Assigns As his and their own proper Goods and Chattels but to be subject to the payment thereof of all my Just Debts and funeral Expences and I hereby Manifest and declare that my leaving my Son Samuel the largest share of my Property does not arise from any Diminution of regard for my said Son Phinehas having at one time intended to leave them equal proportions thereof but as my said Son Phinehas is since so advantageously settled in the world I think it my Duty to make the above extra provision for my said Son Samuel and I do constitute and appoint my said Son in Law Nicholas Peter Phene Executor of this my Will In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the twelfth day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Six *Sarah Phene*
