Absent Without Leave

Thomas Jones, Private in the Australian Imperial Force (AIF) - 31st Battalion. 3rd Reinforcement. Found guilty, 31st December, 1917, of being absent without leave from noon 24th December until he surrended to Military Police at Dinton Railway Station at 8.30pm on 28th December, 1914. Awarded forfeiture of 12 days pay; total forfeiture 17 days pay.
