The Treasurer of the Salisbury Infirmary reports the following collections from the under mentioned parishes after Divine Service on Wednesday last, the day of Humiliation, paid by the respective Clergymen:-

Great Cheverill, 2 ℓ 1 s.; Edmonsham, 1 ℓ 15 s.; Great Wishford, 3 ℓ 13 s. 6 d.; Dinton, 3 ℓ 1 s. 6 d.; Teffont Magna, 18 s. 8 d.; Britford, 25 ℓ 0 s. 4 d.;

The collection for the Salisbury Infirmary at Dinton Church was 7 ℓ 3 s. 6 d. and at Teffont Chapel, 1 ℓ 13 s. 6 d.

DINTON WITH TEFFONT MAGNA

The day of humiliation for the cattle plague was observed in this parish in Friday, the 9^{th} instant. Collections were made on the following Sunday in aid of the National Society for the Education of the Poor in the Principles of the Established Church. The collection in Dinton amounted to 6 ℓ . 2 s. 3 d., and that in Teffont Magna to 1 ℓ . 4 s. 3 d.
