Newspaper Reports

Mark Barnes 11th December, 1841

Mr Sylvester held an inquest at Dinton, on Saturday, the 11th inst., on view of the body of Mark Barnes, aged 55 years, who retired to rest on the evening of the 9th inst.; and it was discovered by his wife, in about two hours, that the vital spark had fled. He had followed his customary employment the same day.

Verdict, "Died by the Visitation of God."
