Dinton



Destructive Fire

On Tuesday night a farm-house and buildings, at Dinton, in the occupation of Mrs Wright, (a widow), with nine children, were destroyed by fire; none of her stock was insured. Two other houses were entirely destroyed, and another materially damaged by the same fire. The latter three houses were the property of Mr Walter Bailey, and were fortunately insured in the Sun Fire Office.

By the late fire at Dinton, (a short account of which appeared last week), we understand that a laboring man and his wife, and a widow woman, all honest and industrious people, have lost nearly all their property; another widow woman, who has four children, sustained considerable loss, as did also the occupier of a house that was much damaged.
