£50 TAKEN FROM A CUPBOARD

Dinton House, the residence of Mr Bertram Philipps, a Salisbury County magistrate, was broken into on Friday night and £50 in cash was found to be missing.

Mr Philipps was in the north of England, and the house was unoccupied at the time. The cash, which was in a cupboard, had been placed there the day before in readiness to pay the wages of the staff on Saturday.

Entry was made through a window. The police are investigating.
