Mixed Dept.</p> <p>The Discipline is good, the children are well behaved and industrious and the work of the school is carried on industriously.</p> <p>The written exercises are neatly done, attention has been paid, in the first class, to the cultivation of oral expression and composition in the division is creditable; in the lower Division this subject is too formally developed to result in freedom of expression. There is some weakness in Arithmetic due rather to an insufficient demand for effort from the children than to lack of instruction. Reading is fluent in the first class and the subject maths is creditably understood; in the lowest Division more success in overcoming the mechanical difficulties of reading is desirable.</p> <p>In Geography some advance in map reading is evident in the first class but in this, as in other subjects, the sectionalising of this division would result in better progress by both parts of the class; in the lower division collective answering should be avoided.</p> <p>Infants Class</p> <p>The children in this class are orderly and are satisfactorily managed but the methods of teaching should be less mechanical.</p> <p>Some re-arrangement of pegs in the Infant Cloak Room is necessary, hoppers in the lower panes of the large windows are desirable and the heating of each room is probably inadequate in cold weather.</p> <p>A new fireguard is needed in the Infants Room and the playground is much overgrown with weeds.</p> <p>Date of visit July 22nd 1914.
