Dinton is a township, village, railway station and parish, 9 miles west from Salisbury station, 74 from London, 7 east from Hindon and 6 west from Wilton, in the hundred of Warminster, Wilton union, Salisbury county court district, Salisbury bishopric and archdeaconry, and Chalke deanery, South Wilts, situated on the river Nadder.

It is known as the birth-place of the celebrated Lord Clarendon.

The church of St Mary, which is in the Early English style, and decorated, is built in the form of a cross, with square tower rising from the centre, with 6 fine-toned bells. The Rev. James Charles Stafford, B.D. incumbent.

The population, in 1851, was 538; there are about 2,400 acres.

Lord Pembroke is lord of the manor.

Marshwood House is half a mile north.

Letters are received through Salisbury; arrive at 5.45 a.m. dispatched at 7.45 p.m. The nearest money order office is at Hindon.
