Wilful Damage to Church

At the petty sessions on Wednesday (Before Mr R. Graves, chairman; Mr J. Locke, Mr V.F. Benett-Stanford, and Mr A. Morrison), Thomas Wright, John Yates, Samuel Whatley, and John James, of Dinton, were summoned by the Rev. C. Humphrey Cholmeley, for tearing down the Christmas decorations in Dinton Church, and breaking one of the church windows, on the night of the 27th ult. Defendants pleaded guilty to the charge, and were each ordered to pay 2s. 6d. damage and the costs.
