The following prisoners appear upon the calendar for trial at the Wilts Quarter Sessions, which commence Tuesday next at Devizes. Reuben Short, 37, sheep stealing at Donhead St. Andrew and stealing wheat at Ansty. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 20 December 1839**

Committed to Fisherton Gaol. Reuben Short, of Donhead Saint Andrew, charged with having feloniously stolen a fat sheep, the property of John Bennett also charged with feloniously stealing a sack of wheat, the property of William Edwards at Ansty. **Salisbury & Winchester Journal, Monday, 4 November 1839**
