Sudden Death of a child. An inquest was held by Mr. R. M. Wilson, at Donhead St. Mary, on Wednesday last, touching the death of a child, named Edwin Ernest Adams. The deceased was about five months old, and had been subject to fits. On Sunday he had had one of these fits, and his parents sent for Mr. Foot, surgeon, but the child died in about five minutes, after it was seized. Mr. Foot was of opinion that death was caused by a kind of epileptic fit. Verdict accordingly. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 1 December 1866**
