1821

Committed to Fisherton Gaol John Hayter, of Redlinch, labourer, charged with having stolen, on the night of the 2nd instant, a quantity of straw, the property of John Baily, at Redlinch. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 8 October 1821

1833

Committed to Fisherton Gaol. George Moody, of Redlinch, Downton, charged with having on the 12th instant, maliciously cut and wounded Henry Bryant, with intent, &c. Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833
