**1779**

Died August 7th John Cooper, Esq., in Pall Mall, Member for Downton, in Wiltshire. **Town & County Magazine, 1779**

Died. November Thomas Buncombe, Esq., at his seat at Helmsley, in Yorkshire. Lately elected Member for Downton, in Wilts, and High Sheriff of the County of York. **Town & County Magazine, 1779**

**1788**

Wednesday last died, after a few days illness, at Mrs Wapshare's, in the Close, with whom she was upon a visit, Mrs Worden, of Downton; a lady whose death is much lamented by a numerous family, and a respectable circle of acquaintance. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 29 December 1788**

**1789**
