Horses Stolen From Mr. James Read At Charlton

It is a matter of general remark, that the crime of horse stealing increases throughout the country, and therefore calls for the severest punishment of the law. A black hackney mare, and a brown cart gelding, both valuable animals rising four years old, were on Monday night last stolen from the stable of Mr James Read, at Charlton, near this city; and a reward of 10 guineas for a discovery of the offenders has hitherto been offered in vain.
