SALE OF DURRINGTON ESTATE

Last week Messrs. Waters and Rawlence offered for sale by auction, at their rooms, Salisbury, the Durrington estate, which comprised the mansion, erected by the owner about thirty years ago, and the adjoining farm, best known as having formerly been for many years in the occupation of the late Mr John Rowden. The mansion, farm, and small rectorial tithe rent charge, comprising the first three lots in the printed particulars, were offered as a whole, and finally knocked down at £11,100. Lot 4, a small outlying copyhold property made £165. Lot 5, a detached dwelling-house with about 1 ½ acres of land, £150; and lot 6, a small freehold dwelling-house, £175, the whole making a total of £11,590.
