About 12 or 14 able bodied agricultural labourers with their wives (several of whom had infants in their arms) and families, amounting altogether to 37, passed through Devizes yesterday on their way to Bristol, where they are to embark for Upper Canada. – They are from the parish of Durrington, in this county, and were attended by the overseer. They appeared in excellent spirits.
