Sudden Death

Mr. Cardell, deputy coroner, held an inquest, on Tuesday, on the body of George Smith, aged 46 years, who died on Monday morning, about three o'clock. His wife heard him moaning, and she at once got a light, and found him almost black in the face, and he died in a few minutes. Mr. Pyle attributed his death to apoplexy, and the jury returned a verdict of "Visitation of God."
