Parish Council Meeting 1898

Local Affairs

A Parish Council meeting was held in the Schoolroom on Monday. Present: Messrs. Jenner, C. Sandell, Rivers, Spreadbury, Harris and Thomas Toomer. The Rev. C. Ruddle was elected to the chair for the ensuing year. Mr. Charles Sandell and Mr. Rivers were appointed overseers, Mr. Macklin and Mr. Thomas Toomer were appointed allotment wardens. The Chairman gave notice he should move at the next meeting that the Council take up the repair of the public paths of the parish, not parallel with the roads, and a precept was ordered to be served on the overseers equal to 1½d. rate estimated to meet expenses.
