John Maton was summoned for refusing to contribute towards the support of his mother, who had become chargeable to the parish of Durrington, and ordered to pay 1s. 6d. a week.

Samuel Baker, David Baker and Thomas Baker were summoned for refusing to contribute towards the support of their father and mother, who have become chargeable to the same parish, but as the defendants did not appear to possess sufficient means, the Bench dismissed the case.
