

Durrington is a village 2 miles north-west from Amesbury north-west, and 10 miles from Salisbury north-west, in the Hundred and Union of Amesbury, on the river Avon. The living is a perpetual curacy, value £100, in the gift of the Dean and Chapter of Winchester; the Rev. Richard Webb, M.A., is the present incumbent. The church is an ancient structure, in the Norman style, with handsome tower.

There is a parochial school, supported by voluntary contributions and a chapel for Independents.

In 1841 the population was 465; the acreage 2,682.

The manor is held by the Warden and Fellows of Winchester College.
