We, the undersigned, being Landowners within the Parish of East Knoyle, in the county of Wilts, whose interest is not less than one fourth part of the whole value of the Lands subject to Tithes in the said parish, do, by this notice, in writing under our hands, call a Parochial Meeting of Landowners and Titheowners within the limits of the said parish, for the purpose of making an Agreement for the general Commutation of Tithes within the limits of the said parish, pursuant to the provisions of an Act passed in the sixth and seventh years of the reign of his late Majesty, King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales;" and we do hereby also give Notice that such Meeting will be held at the Church, in the said parish, on Wednesday, the twenty seventh day of September next, at the hour of twelve in the forenoon.
