GOLDEN WEDDING – Mr. and Mrs. James Newman celebrated their golden wedding at their residence, Worton House, Devizes, on Tuesday; having been married at the Parish Church, Edington, by the Rev. Samuel Littlewood, M.A., on May 2nd, 1866, when they succeeded his father at the Church Farm, Edington. Here their ten children were born, namely, five sons and five daughters, and all were baptised at the Parish Church. There are nine married, and besides the ten children mentioned above, other descendants include 26 grandchildren and one great grandchild.
