



New Vicar Appointed 1780

On Wednesday last the Rev. Francis Kelly Maxwell, Clerk, M.A was instituted, by the Right Rev. the Lord Bishop of Sarum, to the vicarage of Enford, in the county of Wilts and diocese of Sarum, (which lately became vacant by the death of the late Rev. and learned Mr. William Cooke) on the presentation of the Mayor and Commonalty, and Citizens of the city of London, Governors of the possessions, revenues, and goods of the hospitals of Edward the Sixth, King of England, of Christ's, Bridewell, and St. Thomas the Apostle.
