1823

Committed to the Old Bridewell, Devizes Charles King and Rich. Stephens, of Etchilhampton, charged with breaking open the barn of Mr Jas. Barry, and stealing 7 ducks. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 11 August 1823**

1838

Committed To The New Prison, Devizes Mary Hibberd, Elizabeth Shergold, Elizabeth Shergold the younger, and Harriet North, for six weeks each, for maliciously destroying a quantity of young trees in a plantation, the property of J. S. W. E. Drox, esq, of Etchilhampton. **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday 22 February 1838, Page 3, Col. 1 & 2**
