A Register Book (paper) for Marriages conformable to the Act of 26 George II, for the chapel of Itchilhampton. All "of Etchilhampton" and "batchelor" and 'spinster" unless otherwise stated.

Marriages were solemnized from 1755 to 1771 by Henry Jaques, curate, and June 1780, Minister; Oct 1766 by Thos. Markes, Minister; 1772 to Apr 1809 by George Jaques, curate; 1777 by Francis Rogers, Minister; Nov 1776 by T.Bond, Minister, 1801 by Henry Davis, Rector; by Geo.Nankwell, Dec 1809 to 1810, and by Thos. Anth. Methuen, Rector, 1811-12.
