



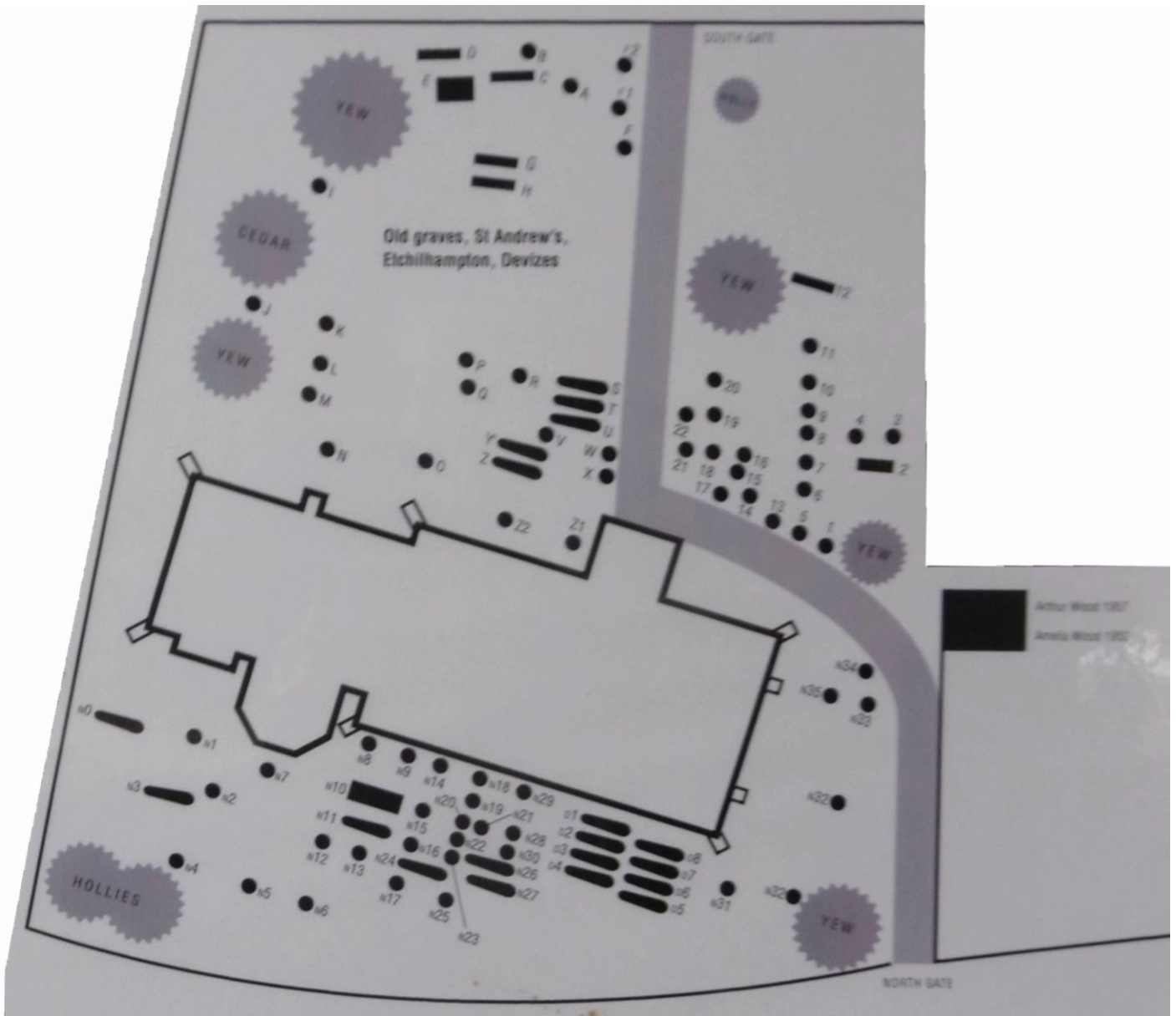
Etchilhampton Churchyard Memorials with Map

I have not heard of the term “body stone” mentioned in this document. They appear to be styles of coffin ledgers.



Wall Shield on outside wall of nave, lists:

William Dorchester died 1720

William Dorchester his son, died 1721

Mary Dorchester his daughter died 1721

Elizabeth Dorchester wife of William died 1722

Mrs Sarah Merewether, wife of Francis, died 1766, aged 55

Francis Merewether, senior, gent, died 1781, aged 67

Sarah Merewether daughter of Francis and Sarah died 1793, aged 42

D2 Sarah Merewether died 1766 aged 55 (eldest daughter of William and Elizabeth
D3 Dorchester)

D4 . . . Dorchester 1799, aged 60 years (Roger Dorchester, father of William in D8)

D7 John Dorchester 1701 (son of Roger, and brother of William?)

D8 William Dorchester son of William?

William Dorchester died 1720, aged 47

Mary his daughter died 1720, aged 20
