



The Rainfall

The aggregate rainfall for January in this locality was slightly below the average with 2.27 inches. This compares with 3.165 inches in January 1939 and an average, for this particular month, of 3.237 inches over the past five years. Temperatures were on the low side, with a maximum sun reading of 52 degrees on the 23rd, while on the night of the 14th the mercury fell to 18 degrees or 14 degrees of frost.
