Thomas Gaby's Cloth Machines Destroyed

Wilts Special Commission, Salisbury, Wednesday

Isaac Miller, **Thomas Piggott**, and **John Romain**, were indicted for riotously assembling and destroying certain machinery used in the manufacture of cloth, the property of **Thomas Gaby**, of Figheldon.

The prosecutor stated that a mob came to his house on the 22nd of November, and destroyed several carding machines. The damage done amounted to about \pounds 150. The prisoners were identified as being among the mob.

The Jury found the prisoners Guilty.
