Fíttleton 1850-1899

1855

It may be interesting to our readers in this neighbourhood to know that the Rev. T. Pearse, BD, Fellow of Magdalen College, Oxford, and Chaplain to the Baroness North, has been offered the Rectory of Fittleton, Wilts. Oxford Journal Saturday 10 February 1855

1867

On Friday the 13th inst, a Harvest Thanksgiving Service was held in Fittleton Church, and after a sermon by the rector from Psalm xxiv 1, "The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof; the works, and they that dwell therein", a collection was made in behalf of the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, amounting to £2 9s 6d. 1885

1886

The Rev. Walter H. Kewley, MA. Chaplain of Magdalen College, and Vicar of Oakley, Bucks, formerly Curate of Headington, has been presented by the President and Fellows of Magdalen College to the Rectory of Fittleton, Wilts.
