The will of Richard Spencer, Esq., army surgeon, 21st Light Dragoons, late of Fonthill Gifford, was proved in London by his brother, Joseph Frowd Spencer, Esq., and testator's nephew, Edward Richardson, Esq., the joint acting executors. The personality was sworn under £90,000. The will was dated December 24th, 1859, and testator died August 6th last. He leaves to his nieces, Anne and Elizabeth Richardson, his share and interest in the freehold at Fonthill Gifford; to his sister, Ellen Richardson, £500; to his brother, J.F. Spencer, £500; Mrs Mary Ann Pringle, £300; the residue, real and personal, to be divided amongst his nephews and nieces, the children of his deceased brother, Edward Spencer, his sister, Ellen Richardson, and his brother, J. F. Spencer. There are legacies to his servants.
