This is the last Will and Testament of me Theodore Burleton of Stop in the Parish of ffonthill Gifford in the County of Wilts Clerk made this twenty fifth day of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and fforty two ffirst I hereby charge and make lyable all my estate both real and Personal with the Payment of my Debts Legacies and ffunerall Expences Also my Will and desire is that my Executrix hereafter named Shall have no further or other Benefit or Interest in my late Brother Robert Burleton's Estate than the Principal Sum of ffifty pounds advanced to Mr John Nicholas on his Assigning to me my said Brother Robert Burleton's Mortgage or grant of his right by and under the last Will and Testament of Robert Burleton my late ffather deceased and the growing interest thereof until paid and not otherwise Also my Will and desire is that my Executrix hereafter named Shall have no further or other Benefit or Interest in my late Sister Dorothy Nicholas Estate than the Principal Sum of Sixty three pounds advanced to Mr John Nicholas and also the farther sum of

Twenty Pounds for which I am engaged to my Aunt Elizabeth Nicholas for so much due to her from my late Sister Dorothy Nicholas on the said Mr John Nicholas Assigning to me all the estate and interest of my late Sister Dorothy Nicholas by and under the last Will and Testament of my said late ffather deceased and James Vining her late Husband deceased or either of them and the growing interest thereof till paid but that the same shall be redeemable by my Nieces Dorothy Vining and Elizabeth Vining on payment of the said Principal Sums of Sixty three Pounds and twenty Pounds and all interest thereof and not otherwise Also all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal of what nature or kind soever I Give devise and bequeath unto Hannah my loving Wife whom I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Sole and whole Executrix and Residuary Legatee of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and Year above written *Theod Burleton*
