

FOXLEY, a township, small village, and parish, in the Hundred and Union of Malmesbury, from which it is distant 3 miles south-west, and 10 north-west from Chippenham. The living is a rectory, in the gift of Lord Holland, who is lord of the manor; the Rev. George Marsh, M.A., is the present incumbent, and the Rev. Lewis Way, B.A., curate. The church is a neat edifice, with a square tower.

The area is 665 acres, and the population 63.
