Fyfield

A SMALL village 3 miles from Marlborough, and 9½ from Calne. Fyfield is in the Devizes Division of Wilts, Union, County Court District and Petty Sessional Division of Marlborough, and Diocese of Salisbury. The register of the Church of St. Nicholas dates from 1682. The living is a chapelry in the parish of West Overton (see Overton). The Olympia Agricultural Company Limited, are the principal landowners. Area, 1,656 acres; rateable value, £875; population 179. Letters arrive through Marlborough, and the post box closes at 10.55 a.m. and 7.50 p.m. weekdays. Overton is the nearest Money Order and Telegraph Office.
