In the name of God Amen November 7th 1732 I Thomas Vivash Junior in the Parish of Great Beding labourer being in health and sound memory at present thanks be to Almighty God for the same do hereby make my last will and testament in manner as followeth First I commend my soul into the hand of Almighty God my creator My body I commit to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor hereafter mencioned and as touching my wordly goods which it has pleased God to bless me with dispose of them in manner as followeth Item I give to my brother's to sons Richard and John one shilling a piece Item I give to my brother William's to sons William and Thomas one shilling a piece Item I give to my brother's three daughters Mary Dier Edfith Dixon and Elizabeth May one shilling a piece All the rest residue and remainder of my goods chattels and personable estate house and housingall ready money and debts due to me after my funeral is discharged I give unto Anne my sister the wife of Richard Dowland of Axford I make and ordaine my sister Anne the wife of Richard Dowling sole executor of this my last will and testament revoking and denying all other wills in words and writing in witness whereof I have heare unto set my hand and seal Signed and sealed in the presence of us:
