**1857**

July 27th, aged 93, the Rev. Richard Warner, Rector of Chelwood and Great Chalfield, Wilthshire, greatly beloved and respected. The deceased was formerly and for many years, curate of St. James's Church, Bath. He was author of "The History of Bath" published in 1800, as well as many other antiquarian and literary productions. **Wiltshire Independent 6 August 1857**

**1866**

On the 29th ult., at Great Chalfield Susannah, relict of the late Mr. William Spackman, in her 82nd year. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 3 November 1866**

Clergymen deceased April 29th at 12 Park Terrace, Oxford, the Rev. George Mullins, Rector of Great Chalfield, Wilts. **Oxford Journal 4 May 1867**

**1871**

Druce-Mullins At the Church of the Holy Trinity, Upper Tooting, by the Rev. E. D. Cree, Vicar, A. F. Milton Druce of Twelve Acres, Eynsham, Oxford to Henrietta Jane, eldest daughter of the late Rev. George Mullins, Rector of Great Chalfield, Wilts, November 30th. No cards. **Pall Mall Gazette 4 December 1871**

**1873**

December 18th, at Corsham, Wilts, J. J. H. Cole, only son of Jeremiah Isaac and Ellen Maria Cole of Lenton, Great Chalfield, Wiltshire, aged 8 years 11 months. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette 25 December 1873**

**1879**

MULLINS, Susannah, widow of the Rev. G., Rector of Great Chalfield, Wilts, at Fyfield, Berkshire, [residence of her son-in-law] aged 74, November 24th. **Pall Mall Gazette 27 November 1879**

**1899**

KINGSTON, October 29th at Formosa, The Spa, Melksham, the Rev. Ed. Kingston, MA, for 21 years Rector of Great Chalfield. **Bristol Mercury 3 November 1899**
