## *Great Cheverell 1800-1849*



**1841**

Salisbury Assizes      William Sloper, charged with stealing hay, at Cheverell.      Not Guilty.  
**Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, March 8 1841**

**1846**

Committed to the New Prison, Devizes      Noah Bailey, for 14 days, for having assaulted and beat  
John Ridout at Great Cheverell.      **Devizes & Wiltshire Gazette, 16 April 1846**

**1847**

James, Thomas and Joseph Gittings, three brothers, were summoned by the overseer of Great Cheverell, for refusing to contribute towards the support of their father who had become chargeable to that parish - Joseph had agreed to join with the others in paying an equal sum for the purpose, but they had refused to comply. They were each ordered to pay 1s.6d a week together with the expenses of this hearing.
