Entitled to wear the South African Medal with 3 clasps; Kings Service Medal with 2 clasps.										
Obituary was printed in the Wiltshire Telegraph on 29th August 1914										

His wife Dora remarried in 1916 to Francis A. Spencer in St. Martin's London
