

King Brothers - Emigration to Utah, USA

The 1881 UK census shows the King family at Great Wishford:-

Parents William King, 38, Ag lab, wife Matilda, 27, and children, Rose, 9, William G., 7, Clara E, 5, Bessie M, 3, and Frederick, 11 months, all born at Wishford.

The 1891 census shows the family living at the Royal Oak, Wishford:-

William, 49, an agricultural groom, Matilda, 39, William G, 17, a shepherd, Bessie, 13, Frederick, 10, Sydney H., 6, Ethel, 7, Charles, 5 and Thomas, 4.

The 1901 census at Great Wishford, records parents William King, 58, a shepherd, and Matilda King, 48 and sons Sidney H. King, 18, a navvy, and Thomas King, 14, an agricultural worker.

By 1910, William, 36, Fred, 29, brother, Harold, 27 are living in Utah, USA.

The 1910 US Census, Bridgeport, Uintah, Utah, records:-

William G. King, 36, widowed, arrived in the United States in 1894, Flockmaster (sheep), born England; Fred King, 29, single, brother, arrived in the United States in 1900, naturalized, flockmaster (sheep); Harold King, 27, married, brother, arrived US 1902, naturalized, flockmaster (sheep); Maggie King, sister-in-law, 29 and nephews, William King, 5, born in Utah, and Frederick King, 3, born in Utah.

The 1920 US census, at Delta, Colorado shows In the same address:-

Harold S. King, 36, stockman (sheep), emigrated 1900, naturalized 1914, and his family, (2 children 13, and 14, both born in Utah), Fred King, 39, emigrated 1898, naturalized 1913, stockman(sheep), wife Fern and son, 9 months, born in Colorado, and Thomas King, lodger, arrived in US 1904, naturalized 1914, a labourer, herding sheep.

The 1920 US Census, at Dragon, Uintah, Utah shows:-

William King, emigrated 1894, naturalized 1905, farmer, wife Lulu, born Kansas, and children Elizabeth, 6, William, 3 and Florence, 1.
