1814

On Thursday was married, by the Rev. James Birch, Mr. J. Trubridge, of Little Wishford, to Miss Louisa Dredge, Great Wishford. Salisbury And Winchester Journal, 14 February 1814

On Wednesday last was married at Wishford, Mr. G. Jukes, of Hatherly, Somerset, to Ann, youngest daughter of the late Mr. John Rowden, of Wishford.

1815

1823

Died on Saturday, in the 84th year of his age, the Rev. James Birch, B.D. Rector of Great Wishford, Vicar of Ashbury, and late fellow of Magdalen College, Oxford, long and deservedly respected for his inflexible integrity. **Hampshire Chronicle, Monday, 2 June 1823**

Died At Great Wishford, Wilts, aged 96, Grace, relict of Leonard Jesse, Esq. of Dinton. Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 5 June 1823

1826

On Saturday the 18th Inst. was married at Wishford, by the Rev. P. D. Williams, Mr. George Tutt, of Plaitford, to Elizabeth, only daughter of Mr. E. Mandrell, maltster, of Wishford. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday,27 March 1826

Death: In his 18th year, Sidney Smith, fourth son of Mr. William Smith, of Wishford. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 19 October 1826**

1827

On Christmas Day died, Mrs. Ann Turner, aged 83, a respectable inhabitant of Great Wishford. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 8 January 1827

1829

Monday last died Mr. Harry Smokem, carpenter and wheelwright, of Great Wishford. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 8 June 1829

1831

Died, on Tuesday, the ult, aged 77, Mrs. Mary Hinwood, a respectable inhabitant of Wishford Magna, in this county, and widow of the late Mr. John Hinwood, of that place.

1835

Married, a short time since, at Wishford Magna church, near this city, Mr. Giles Munday, aged 70, to Mrs. Sarah Macklin, also aged 70. Mr. George Woodlands, who officiated as father, and Mrs. Woodlands, the bridesmaid, were each in their 63rd year. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 12 October 1835

1836

March 9, Josiah Trubridge, esq., of Wishford, to Marianne, 2nd daughter of the late Edmund Street, esq., of Winchester.

Died, on Tuesday, May 24, at Holton, Somerset, aged 60, Mr. George Rowden, late of Wishford, in this county. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 6 June 1836

Died, Wednesday last, after a lingering illness, aged Ann, wife of Mr. Thomas Smith, cheese-factor, of Fisherton Anger, and only surviving daughter of Mr. Giles Munday, of Wishford. Salisbury And Winchester Journal, 7 November 1836

Married, on Saturday, December 31, Mr. R. Scammell, South Newton, to Miss Lucretia Shergold, of Great Wishford. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 2 January 1837

1839

Died, at Wishford, on Friday last, November 8, in her 78th year, Mrs. Hide, much respected by a large circle of friends. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 11 November 1839

Died, November 6, at Great Wishford, Wilts, Susanna, relict of Mr. Thomas Marks, Dinton, aged 74 Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 25 November 1839

1840

Married, at Wishford, on the 9th inst., Mr. Shergold, to Miss May, both of the same place. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 30 November 1840

1841

July 3rd, at Wishford Magna, Wilts, the Rev. W. W. Tireman, Rector of Bowers Gifford, in this county, to Harriet Octavia, youngest daughter of the late John Williams, Esq., Commissioner of Customs. **Essex Standard, Friday, 9 July 1841**

1843

Died, on Wednesday last, Mr. H. Bracher, of Great Wishford, aged 63 years. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal**, **20 June 1843**

Died on Tuesday, at Great Wishford, in her 83rd year, Alice, relict of Mr. John Trubridge. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 8 July 1843

1849

Died, on Sunday last, at Great Wishford, John, second son of the late Mr. H. Bracher, aged 38 years. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 14 April 1849

On the 9th inst., at Great Wishford, Herbert, third son of the late Mr. Henry Bracher, aged 34 years. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 15 December 1849
