Quarter Sessions 1603

The presentments at the Hilary Sessions January 1602/3, 45 Eliz., include:-

The minister, John Bower, and parishioners of Great Wishford write on 11 December to represent the case of a woman named Michael [sic] London, apparently holding a small farm, who is very ill treated by an unnatural son, William London.
