Wishford - Parish Council Officers. At the first meeting of the Parish Council, held on the evening of the 13th inst., Mr. George Plowman was unanimously elected chairman, Mr. J. Wallis, vice-chairman, Mr. T. E. Fifield, clerk, and Mr. Joseph Thatcher, treasurer.
