1744

Memorandum that On July 7th 1744 H. Stephens A.M. Was by the Revd. Mr. Baker Vicar of Hungerford, inducted into the Rectory of Hamm vacant by the Decd of the Revd. Mr. Philip Hayward, who succeeded in the said Rectory the Revd. Mr. Richard Gillingham on May 2nd 1719.
