## 1850-1899

- 1851** Birth On the 17<sup>th</sup> inst., at Hankerton Vicarage, Wilts, the wife of the Rev John Henry Wise, of a daughter.  
*Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 22 November 1851*
- 1855** Married On the 1<sup>st</sup> inst., at Hankerton, Wilts, by the Rev George Simcocks, Hannah, youngest daughter of the late Mr David Cole, of Park Farm, Charlton, to George Kent, second son of the late Mr George Hanks, saddler, Malmesbury, Wilts.

- 1867** Married Dec 5, at the parish church, Cliff Pipard, Henry, youngest son of John Maskelyne, Esq., of Hankerton, to Sarah, youngest daughter of the late Mr R Smith, of Shorn Hill, Wootton Bassett, Wilts.

- 1868** Married Sept 22, at Trinity Church, Hazlemere, Bucks, by the Rev Hugh Allan, M.A., brother in law of the bride, assisted by the Rev George Allan, M.A., brother of the bride, the Rev William J Buckland, M.A., vicar of Hankerton, Wilts, to Helen Somerset, third daughter of the Rev George Allan, M.A., vicar of Hazlemere.

- 1870** Married On the 10<sup>th</sup> inst., at the Primitive Methodist Chapel, Malmesbury, by the Rev E Hancock, Mr Alfred Kimbrey to Miss Mary Jane Kibblewhite, of Hankerton.

- Married On the 11<sup>th</sup> inst., at the Abbey Church, Malmesbury, by the Rev C Pitt, vicar, Mr Edward Grant, of the Market Cross, Malmesbury, to Miss Jane Sparrow, of Hankerton.

- 1872** Died Aug. 20, at Hankerton, Mrs Mary Beale, aged 85.

- 1878** Died April 27, at Hankerton, Malmesbury, of paralysis, Mr Thomas Woodward, aged 76.

- Married August 1, at the parish church, Westport, by the Rev S Rogers, curate, Arthur, second son of Mrs Jobbins, grocer, Hankerton, to Eliza, youngest daughter of Mr John Fullaway, The Gastons, Malmesbury.

- Married Nov 16, at the Congregational Chapel, Westport, Malmesbury, by the Rev Geo. Morgan, Mr Joseph Saunders of Crudwell, to Fanny Emmeline, second daughter of Mr J Painter of Hankerton.

- 1881** Birth March 8, at Hankerton, the wife of Mr George Lambert, a son.

- 1883** Birth At Hankerton, near Malmesbury, the wife of Ernest Richard Palamountain (of Gloucester) of a daughter surviving its birth five hours only.

- 1884** Died Jan 19, at Hankerton, Mr Henry Bishop, aged 35 years.

- 1885** Died Aug. 5, John Law, of Hankerton, aged 64.

- Married Nov 21, at Westport Church, Malmesbury, by the Rev W Jones, Mr Walter Fennell, of Hankerton, to Rachel, daughter of Mr Henry Price, of Malmesbury.

- 1886** Died May 14<sup>th</sup>, at Hankerton, Thomas Jones, aged 73 years.

- Married July 27, at the Abbey Church, Malmesbury, by the Rev W Jones, George Parsloe, of Malmesbury, to Emily Jones, of Hankerton.

- 1887** Married May 25, at Maisey Hampton, Charles Plummer, of Hankerton, eldest son of the later Henry Plummer, Stone's Farm Cricklade, to Susan Ann Mary, third daughter of Nevil Cuss

- 1889** Died April 3<sup>rd</sup>, at the workhouse, Malmesbury, Job Garland, late of Hankerton, aged 76 years.

- Died July 17<sup>th</sup>, at Hankerton, after a short illness, Enoch Norgrove, aged 37 years.

- 1898** Married Nov. 17, by the Rev Tyrell, at the Parish Church, Biddeston, Jenny, youngest daughter of the late George Major, of Hankerton, Malmesbury, Wilts, to Herbert, youngest son of John Cose, of Hillside Cottage, Cloford, Frome, Somerset.
