



Rev. Harry Kenrick Adkin
Vicar of Hankerton 1904 - 1910

Harry Kenrick Adkin was born in Abergavenny in 1851 to Rev. Henry Adkin and Dorcas Kenrick.

On 9th January 1878 he married Georgina Elizabeth Knight, daughter of James Peter Knight and Georgina Louisa Mills.

They had five children James Harry 1878-1948, Walter 1880-1957, Frederick John 1883-1964, Georgina Noel 1886-1955 and Violet Doris 1889-1908.

He died in Bristol in 1928 and Georgina two years later.

He gained a B.A at London University in 1877 and for twenty years he was mathematics teacher at Glyngarth School, Cheltenham
